

- Submit with the application three copies of a drawing showing location and extent of work to be done. Maps and drawings filed with an application for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permit for works in navigable waters will be acceptable under Section 429(b).
- 3. Applications by counties, cities, towns and villages shall be signed by the chief executive officer thereof or the head of the department or agency undertaking the project.
- 4. The applicant must publish a "Notice of Application". The Local Permit Agent, to whom the application is delivered, will furnish the form of notice and instructions for publication.
- 5. If other than owner mokes application, written consent of the owner must accompany application.
- 6. Acceptance of a permit subjects permittee to restrictions, regulations or obligations stated in application and permit.
