Dear Sir,

At a recent board of directors meeting of the Port Bay Improvement Association, it was voted that I carry out the duties necessary to obtain permission for the proposed Port Bay Outlet.

Referring to your letter of March 27, 1941 (file no. 7243), I am returning one plan copy with the outlet location marked in red pencil. I have also proceeded according to instruction in form 96a, and have enclosed a plan on tracing linen and 3 prints. The outlet will be 30 feet wide with sloping sides with 3 feet of water above M.L.W. of 244.0' elevation, 15 feet wide. The channel is to be cut 60 feet through a gravel bar. The retaining pier will be constructed of oak piles 20 feet long and 12 inches in diameter. The piles will be staggered on 5 foot centers with 12 inch timbers securely fastened horizontally.

between them. The gravel will be moved by drag line and deposited on upland property.

The outlet will be situated in the township of Huron: Town clerk is Mr. Feunis S. Fowler of Wolcott, New York. The property is owned by the Port Bay Improvement Association.

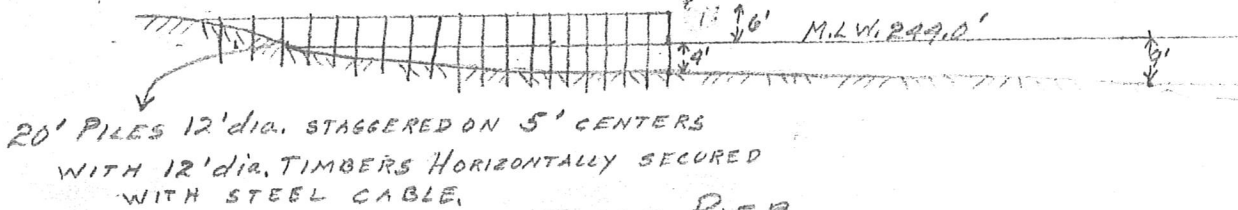

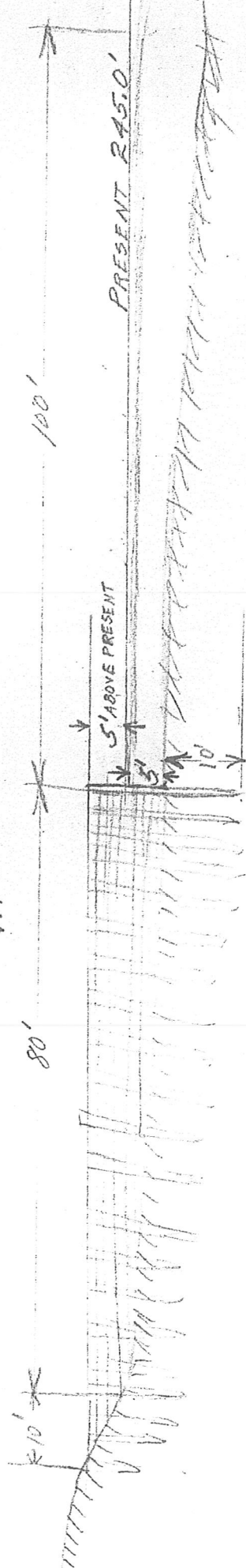

Detailed Elevation

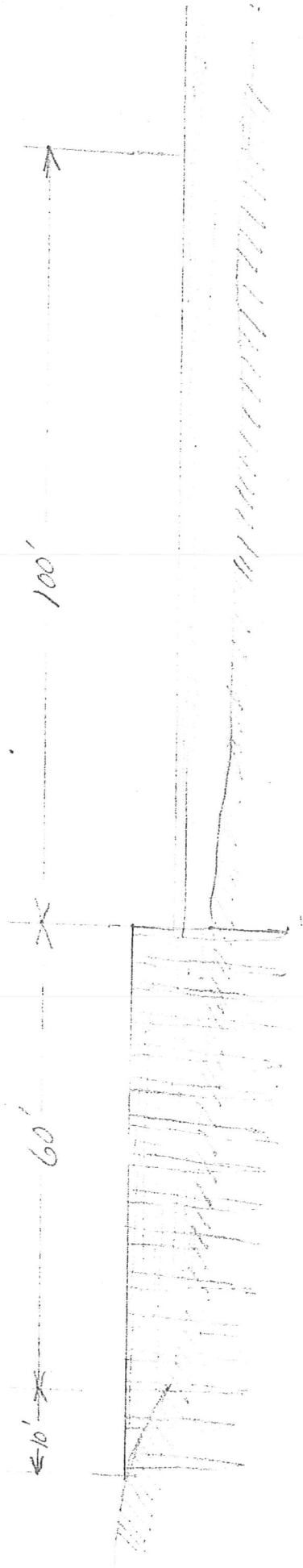

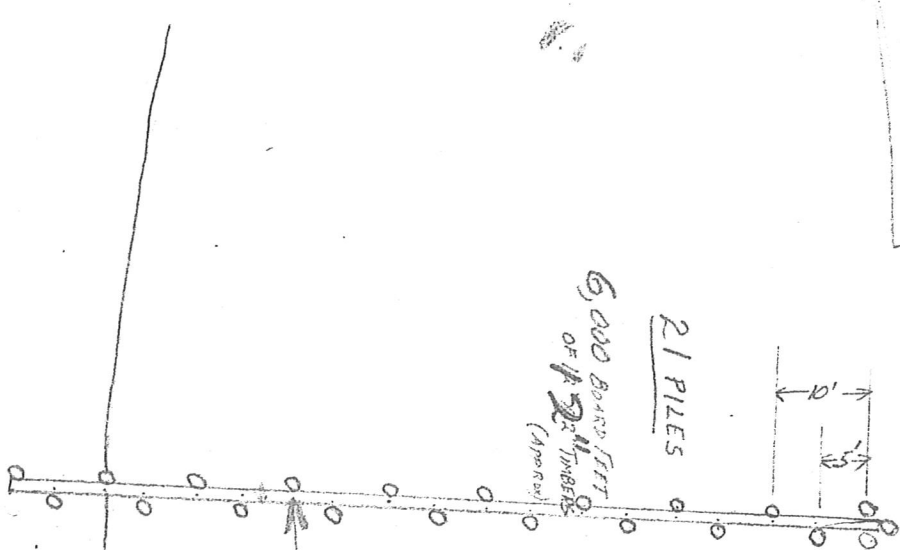

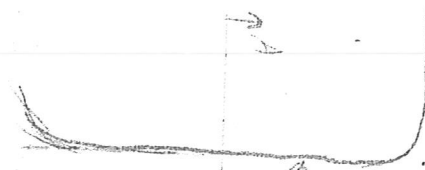
